# **Project Details**

AMS acted as the Client's Engineer, and worked with the contractor to determine bitumen and aggregate spread rates. AMS also carried out the linemarking on the runway, taxiways and apron.

#### Wyndham – January 2016

AMS carried out a seal inspection, provided a seal design and a scope of work, specification and bill of quantities for inclusion in tender documentation.





#### Woodie Woodie – June 2015

AMS corrected a subsiding area of runway over a culvert. The work was tied in with MRWA works the sub-contractor were performing close by, and the client subsequently contracted them directly to perform access road repairs in the same visit, further reducing costs. AMS also carried out a complete re-mark of the runway, taxiway and apron.

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#### Murrin Murrin – December 2014

AMS designed a polymer-modified reseal for the central 12m of the runway which was severely cracked due to the age of the seal, and acted as the Client's Engineer for the physical works, as well as carrying out linemarking.

AMS carried out stabilised patch repairs on the runway and taxiway, along with a shoulder reseal and remarking of the airport.
