# AEROPLANE LANDING AREA ALA COURSE

## Course Overview

Our one (1) day Aeroplane Landing Area course is an abridged version of our full Aerodrome Reporting Officer course. This course specifically relates to the aspects of inspecting an Aeroplane Landing Area (ALA) and the general operation of these aerodromes.

The course focuses on the general advice provided by the Civil Aviation Advisory Publication (CAAP) 92-1 and best practice suggestions for this category of aerodrome, where Aerodrome Reporting Officers are not required to be present.

Whilst training for the operation of ALA's is not mandated, this course provides valuable introductory knowledge and skills which supports the ALA operation and enhances aerodrome safety for those wishing to go beyond the minimum requirements.
